LAST MINUTE CAMP REMINDERS

Wednesday 27th – Friday 29th July

You are all reminded that students **will need to be dropped off at the Bendigo Railway station no later than 9.40am on Wednesday 27th July.**

(DO NOT arrive at 9.00am as there will be no teachers there at that time! From 9.30am onwards please)

Please ensure that your child is marked off on their Grade's class role when they arrive. **Please be punctual as the train cannot wait for latecomers!**

Parents assisting will be able to tell you where to put your luggage, ready to be put onto the train.

Medication:

If medication is required, where possible bring this to school prior to camp, and give it to Miss Hopkins in Room 21 by **Monday 25th July**. Please remember to include a named medicine glass if needed. All medication should be packed in a clearly named zip-lock bag, together with written instructions as to the dose required, times to be given and reasons for the medication.

DO NOT include fresh fruit as we are entering a 'fruit fly free' zone

If your child is permitted to have camp spending money please give it to your child's classroom teacher by Monday 25th July.

Please do not give it to teachers at the Railway Station, as they will have enough to think about ensuring your children and their luggage are safely organized. This money will be given to the students just prior to their timetabled time for shopping.

Water bottle for daily use

Sunscreen

Pencil case with grey lead & coloured pencils

Sleeping Bags:

Please remember that all students, teachers and supervising parents need to bring their own sleeping bag, pillow case and towels.

(Linen is not provided in the lodges) Blankets and bedspreads will be provided.
