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Fun Ways to Practise Spelling Words

1. **ABC order**- Write your words in alphabetical order.
2. **Rainbow Words** - Write your words in three colours
3. **Silly sentences** -Use all your words in ten sentences
4. **Picture words** - Draw a picture and write your words in the picture.
5. **Words into segments** - Write your words in segments as per using 'Soundwaves' grapheme boxes
6. **Story words** - Write a short story using all your words.
7. **Surround words** - Write your words on graph paper and outline in colours.
8. **Ransom words** - Cut out letters in a newspaper/magazine and glue them on a paper to spell your words.
9. **Pyramid Words** - Write your words adding or subtracting one letter at a time. The result will be a pyramid shape of words.
10. **Words-in-words** - Write your word and then write at least 2 words made from each.
11. **Delicious words** - Write your words in whipped cream, peanut butter, or anything you can eat!
12. **Good Clean Words** -Write your words in shaving cream on a bench or some other surface that can be cleaned safely.
13. **Messy Words** - Write your words in mud or sand.
14. **Pasta Words** - Write your words by arranging alphabet pasta or pieces of pasta.
15. **Reversed Alphabetical** - Write your words in ABC (alphabetical order) -backwards!
16. **Create an activity** - Can you think of a fun way to do your spelling activities? Try it out!
17. **Magazine words** - Find your words in an old magazine/newspaper and cut it out and glue it on paper.
18. **Sound Words** - Use a phone, ipad or computer and record saying your words and their spelling. Then listen to yourself, checking to see that you spelled all the words correctly.
19. **X Words** - Write two words having one common letter so they criss-cross.
20. **Other Handed** - If you are right-handed, write with your left, or vice versa.
21. **Silly String** - With a long length of string, "write" words in cursive, using the string to shape the letters.
22. **Backwriting** - Using your finger, draw each letter on a partners' back, having the partner say the word when completed.
23. **Flashwriting** - In a darkened room, use a flashlight to draw letters in the air.
24. **Secret Agent Words** - Number the alphabet from 1 to 26, then convert your words to a number code.
25. **Word find** -make your words into a word find
26. **Teach**- your words to a member of your family
27. **Play doh**- make your words using playdoh
